

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-64**

**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE GRANT OF MONIES  
TO BE USED TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF IN-SQUAD COMPUTERS  
FROM UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE EDWARD BYRNE  
MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM (JAG) AND  
AUTHORIZING FISCAL AGENT/GRANT ADMINISTRATOR**

**WHEREAS**, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) of the United States Department of Justice has awarded a grant of \$26,849 to THE City Of Coon Rapids and Anoka County; and

**WHEREAS**, in agreement with Anoka County, the City of Coon Rapids Police Department has been named to administer the grant monies; and

**WHEREAS**, administering the grant allows the Police Department to be awarded 10 percent of the grant for administrative fees amounting to \$1,059; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coon Rapids Police Department's share of the JAG grant is \$16,256 for a total of \$17,315 to be used toward the purchase of in-squad computers; and

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 465.03 allows cities to accept donations of real or personal property by resolution adopted by a two-thirds majority of Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds the offered donation to be in the public interest;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Coon Rapids, Minnesota that the donation of \$17,315 is hereby accepted.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Coon Rapids hereby extends its gratitude to the U.S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for its generosity.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of Police of the Coon Rapids Police Department or his designee is hereby authorized to be the fiscal agent and administer this grant on behalf of the City of Coon Rapids and the Coon Rapids Police Department and Anoka County.
