

RESOLUTION NO. 16-36

**RESOLUTION REAPPROPRIATING FUNDS WITHIN THE 2016 FACILITY
CONSTRUCTION FUND BUDGET**

WHEREAS, Section 1-700 of the City Charter provides for adoption of an annual budget and the subsequent amendments; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 budget does not include funds for purchase and installation of a new Mohawk A-7A two-post automobile lift (MN State Contract #30024) and removal of existing hoist.

WHEREAS, the new lift will be replacing the existing lift in the City shop which has reached the end of its service life due to both mechanical issues and the inability of the current lift to service newer model vehicles. In order to install the new lift, the existing lift needs to be removed and the cement footings repaired prior to installing the new hoist; and

WHEREAS, the total cost to removal, repair, purchase, and installation of the new hoist is estimated to be \$11,896. The breakdown of the cost is as follows: \$6,246 – Mohawk A-7A (7,000lb two-post lift), \$3,650 – removal of old hoist/installation of new unit, and \$2,000 – allowance for additional electrical work and fast cure concrete; and

WHEREAS, capital outlay purchases must specifically be identified and funded per the City Code 2-803.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Coon Rapids, Minnesota to appropriate funds in the Facility Construction budget of \$11,896 for the purchase and installation of a new two-post automobile lift for use within the City shop.
